- Additional steps taken to share this history with the public
- Application of state or federal preservation laws

One Excellence in Archaeology and Historic Preservation Award and one Certificate of Merit may be given annually. Should a worthy nomination not be received, the award may not be given.

State Historical Society of Iowa employees and Board of Trustees members are not eligible to receive the award.
