The Dorothy Schwieder Excellence in Research Award recognizes on a biennial basis the most significant research and contribution to the body of knowledge in lowa history and is the top research and writing award given by the board.

Dorothy Schwieder was an American historian, biographer and academic. She joined the faculty of lowa State University in 1966 and became an authority in the field of lowa history during her near fifty-year academic career. In addition, she authored lowa: The Middle Land (an engrossing history of lowa) and co-authored lowa: Past to Present (a textbook that highlight's lowa's rich heritage).

The following criteria will be used to select the winner of this prestigious award:

- Contribute research to the body of knowledge in Iowa History
- Create a significant body of work
- Demonstrate professionalism in work

One Dorothy Schwieder Excellence in Research Award may be given biennially. The award will be made in even-numbered years. Should a worthy nomination not be received the award may not be given.

State Historical Society of Iowa employees and Board of Trustees members are not eligible to receive the award.
