- Key Words/Themes: commodity history, pork, beef cattle
- *Summary:* In general, midwestern agriculture expanded along predictable patterns in the years directly after the Civil War. The only variation in Southern Iowa was the intensification of beef cattle rather than dairy cattle, as well as in pork. The author argues that these two products—beef and pork—became the two most important regional commodities.
