Primary Sources

Primary sources are first-hand accounts of your topic created by people or organizations with direct connections to your topic. *Primary sources provide multiple perspectives about your topic from people who were there.*

Examples: Letters, diaries, newspaper articles (written during the time period you are researching), photographs, maps, political cartoons, paintings, speeches, oral histories

Secondary Sources

Secondary sources are accounts of your topic that were not written first-hand by people or organizations with direct connections to your topic. Secondary sources provide descriptions, summaries, analyses, and interpretations of your topic.

Examples: Books, scholarly articles, newspaper articles (written after the time period you are researching), websites, museum exhibits
