BOUNDARY BETWEEN MISSOURI AND IOWA. — The Supreme Court of the United States have decided the boundary question against Missouri and in favor of Iowa. This decision fixes and establishes as the Northern boundary line of Missouri the old Indian boundary line, known as Sullivan's line, which will deprive that State of the county of Schuyler, and some other territory. There is but a very small slave population in the territory of Missouri thus unexpectedly attached to Iowa by the decision of the Supreme Court of the United States, which is final.
